


Permanent Program

Approved by City Council in November 2021

Five operators permitted to deploy scooters and e-bikes between April 1, 2022 – March 31, 2023

1200 e-scooters and 500 e-bikes permitted to operate Citywide





City Code Requirements

Max speed of 15 mph for scooters and 20 mph for e-bikes

Monthly reports: Ridership data, customer complaints, crashes/injuries

Equipment requirements: Information in braille, vehicle demos

Service requirements: 30% in Equity zones, 311 responsiveness

No sidewalk riding citywide



City vehicle cap of 1200 scooters and 800 e-bikes



Majority of rides start and end along Martha Custis Drive






Data Feed

Some data available publicly




Permit Application

Program requirements: Rider education, transit deployments, No Parking and Slow zones, cash payment option and low-income discount program


