

Board Passes Responsible Budget with Minimal Condo Fee Increase

The board began the formal review process for the 2020-21 budget January 25 at the annual budget workshop and further worked on it at the February and March board meetings.

However, getting to a fiscally responsible budget is a process the board and management work on all year long. Throughout the year, the board meets monthly to discuss issues facing the community and review reserve expenditures. Management and board members communicate regularly regarding maintenance and landscaping expenses and improvements. They work as a team throughout the year, not just in the first three months of the year, to reach responsible fiscal outcomes.



ment allows us to meet the physical and financial needs of our association at a minimal increase to residents. Some positive features of our 2020-21 budget include:

- Full funding of our reserves (\$2,691,340)
- Covering an estimated operating budget of \$6,859,190
- Maintaining Homeowner's Equity at \$1,600,000, which is 23% of our operating budget
- Reserving funds for capital improvement
- Investment in landscaping to continue making Parkfairfax even more beautiful
- Investment in critical building infrastructure projects

Spring Clean Up Day


Parkfairfax, in conjunction with the Landscape Committee, will be holding the annual spring cleanup day on Saturday, April 25. Our trash hauler, Capitol Services, will pick up any bagged yard or lawn debris curbside. Parkfairfax staff will remove any larger items such as old grills, patio furniture, etc. All items must be at the curb by 9 a.m. and pickups will stop at 2 p.m. Then, starting May 5, we will begin the property inspection process. During these inspections, building exteriors are checked for roof issues, peeling paint, rotted wood, landscaping issues, etc. At the same time, we will note any unit owner areas that fail to meet the Association guidelines. If an owner is found not to be in compliance, a courtesy reminder will be left in the mail slot.

MANAGER'S CORNER

Parkfairfax Infrastructure Basics

As we are moving through the property performing upgrades, several residents have inquired about these projects and we felt that an overview would help to answer a lot of questions.

Due to our size, Parkfairfax is considered a large-scale community and as such we have miles of underground utilities that service all the buildings. Below are the largest systems with a brief explanation of each.

- Storm Sewer Lines: These lines run from the large catch basins around the buildings where they also pick up many of the gutter downspout drains. They move rain/ground/storm water away from the buildings to outfalls in Four Mile Run. We have an annual program, funded through our reserves, to replace lines, add drain boxes, hard pipe, and reconnect old failed corrugated lines. In the past three years, we have replaced 7,237 linear feet of storm lines at a cost of \$370,000. These lines are all owned by the Association.
- Sanitary Sewer Lines: These lines (also Association-owned) move both brown (toilet) and grey water (sinks, showers, dishwashers) from the buildings out to the city mains in the streets. All lines drain to a large 18-inch main and then off the property to the city treatment facilities. Here, too, we have a funded reserve line to make repairs or replace as needed. In the past three years, we have replaced 4,025 linear feet at a cost of \$340,000. This includes lines within the crawlspaces as well. These lines are the deepest on the site and the majority of the repairs are mostly in rear and open areas. We also have a line jetting program (main flushing), which is performed by our staff with Association-owned equipment.

• Water:

- Cold water: It is fed from the street to buildings in a single, double or triple cluster. The cold-water lines also feed our hot water heaters. Each building has a direct connection.
- Hot Water: There are 40 boiler rooms where there are either two or three large gas- fired commercial hot water heaters. The number of heaters depends on the number of units in the cluster. The hot water is fed to buildings in a circulator loop, meaning that the water is constantly flowing with pumps. The water heater replacement program has seven units (out of 114) remaining. This program began in 2012 and will be completed this year. We will revisit the replacement cycle again starting in 2025 as needed.
- PEX (CROSS LINKED POLYETHYLENE): We began to replace the old copper hot- and cold-water lines in the building crawlspaces in conjunction with the remediation program 2016 and at present we have completed PEX in 160 buildings and crawlspace remediation in 146 buildings. We are proceeding to have both of these programs completed by 2023. This includes the underground inter-building connections as well.
- Electrical: Dominion Electric owns all the underground lines on the property leading up to the meter pans on each end of our buildings. The Association is responsible for the main breaker at the meter pan and the unit owner is then responsible for the line from the meter to their individual breaker panels and all interior wiring. However, in the event that conditions in the crawlspace cause the main line to be damaged, the Association will make the repairs.
- **Gas Lines:** Washington Gas owns all the lines from the street to the meters. The Association owns the line from the meters into the crawlspaces and up to each unit. The unit owners are responsible for the valve and connection to their gas ranges.
- **Site Lighting:** The Association owns and maintains all building floodlights, pool and tennis court lighting. Exterior unit lights are owner's responsibility. Currently there is interest in upgrading the exterior building lights, which will be discussed through the capital program in the near future.

When you call in just let staff know that you would like to pay your bill over the phone, and you will be taken care of from there.

At this time, we can't accept payments over the phone for bike registration, access cards and party room rental. We also can't accept payments for rent checks for those who are tenants of Parkfairfax.





Ward 5 Painting

is tentatively scheduled to begin in June. The contractor will give advance notice to each residence affected by this exterior work on the building trim. Warranty touch-up painting will be performed in Ward 2; touch-up work will be done in-house as needed. Palmer Brothers painters will perform Ward 5 front and rear entry door painting, and convenience keys will be utilized. The keys will be in control of a Parkfairfax Employee who will unlock and remain with the painting crews and will re-lock when completed. The door painting/entry notice will include an Admit Slip that will allow you to provide specific entry instructions. Units with access needs (pets, alarms, etc.) will receive the necessary and appropriate level of coordination required to complete this task. If you choose to stain your door, please be advised that future maintenance of the door's finish will be your responsibility. The Association will not prepare a door for staining, maintain a stained door, or paint over a stained door. If you are renting or selling a unit with a stained front door, please inform your tenant/purchaser of this fact to avoid future misunderstandings. We have included a map (sections and wards) so you can see which areas will be affected this year by contractor painting and touchup.



Feedback Requested: Community Composting Service

Hello friends and neighbors at Parkfairfax!

We have a big opportunity to take climate action in our own hands. We are requesting that Parkfairfax Association offer a Compost Pick-Up service for our community.

A Compost Pick-Up service works just like trash pick-up, except nothing goes into a landfill. All kitchen scraps, BPI-certified compostable products and material that is 100% organic goes into a composting facility where it is converted into soil for your garden. (This soil is shared back with you twice per year, too!)

Compost is collected in air-tight gamma sealed compost bins specifically designed to contain smells and keep pests out. Collection bins come fitted with a compostable liner that is replaced each time the bin is serviced. Each home that registers for the service will be given a compost bin. The composting service can also provide kitchen countertop bins and compostable liners.

On the day of the Compost Pick Up, the composting service will come to your home to empty your bin, replace the compostable liner and return it.







These are an example of what the compost collection bins look like. Their size ranges from 5 gallons to 12 gallons.

If a composting service is offered in Parkfairfax, we can prevent approximately 300 tons to 500 tons of methane from entering the atmosphere each year. That's methane equivalent to the weight of 60 - 100 elephants.
