Parkfairfax Little School Proposal

Objective: To provide a space for children living in Parkfairfax ages kindergarten through third grade to share in a learning experience during COVID times.

Location: Parkfairfax community room

Day and times: Monday through Friday, 3 hours slots in the morning (this will allow for set-up and clean-up), 9:30am-12:30pm

Number of students: 4-6 (and I would consider adding a couple more, depending)

Activities: Students would engage in a variety of learning activities including story time, age appropriate writing assignments, math problems, science experiments, art projects, music play, geography lessons and more.

Other requests: A little spot to store supplies, just a place to put a box would be enough

About me and our group: I have one child, who is 5 ½. I have spoken with a few parents in the neighborhood, who would be interested in joining. Parents would take turns with the lessons. I also have experience as a classroom teacher and kids yoga instructor, another mom is a child counselor, and another mom is has preschool teaching experience.

Possible concerns: In fairness, if other pods want use of the room, we could offer afternoons to another group. We could also make even more availability by doing M, W,F and T, Th both morning and afternoon, which would allow for 4 pods.
