Mark,

I am an owner/resident and in the process of looking into SCUBA open water certification. Since public pools are still closed or operating at reduced hours, the company suggested I reach out to Parkfairfax to see what the policy is on lessons in the Community pools. I understand I could rent Pool A; however, since there are only two of us (me and an instructor) I wanted to ask if it was possible instead to use the pool during normal operating hours without disturbing other residents using the pool (and abiding by life guard breaks). I have seen residents getting private swim lessons, so I am curious about the policies. The time commitment for the SCUBS training is based on student mastery, but this will likely be three 3-hour classes in any of the three Parkfairfax pools (unless one is recommended).

Alternatively, I could rent Pool A and offer a full, two-day class to interested Parkfairfax residents, similar to the Alexandria swim lessons that have been offered in the past; however, that is not my preference since I am already doing my coursework online and scheduling pool training around my work shifts.
