## **HELP THE ENVIRONMENT – ADOPT A TREE!**

Parkfairfax is now planting new trees to replace ones that had to be cut down and to replenish wooded areas. In October, grounds workers and contractors planted several varieties of maple and oak, dogwoods, holly, and a few other species. The Landscape Committee is looking for volunteers willing to adopt a tree – to water it and just keep an eye on it, and let the committee coordinator know if it looks like there is any problem with it. A tag with the first name of the volunteer or a nickname will be put on the tree to let everyone know that someone is caring for it.

The new trees will have a "donut gator bag" on them – you would just have to fill the bag. More information about watering will be provided to you.

This would be a great opportunity to get your children started on caring for the environment. Take them with you when you water your tree and explain to them the need to care for our landscape.
